



Justin Lewis joined Lobbyit as the firm's Government Relations Manager in January 2020. His responsibilities include representing Lobbyit's clients to Congress and the Executive Branch, analyzing legislative and regulatory actions of interest to clients, and strategizing courses of actions to implement clients' policy agendas. Justin also assists with the firm's business development efforts and has begun building his own book of business within the firm.

Prior to joining Lobbyit, Justin was the External Affairs Manager at the Fuel Cell and Hydrogen Energy Association (FCHEA) in Washington, D.C. At FCHEA, Justin assisted with the association's government relations and communications priorities. During this time, he helped to attain record-high appropriations for the U.S. Department of Energy's Hydrogen and Fuel Cell R&D program, reinstate tax incentives critical to the industry's early-market success, and elevate the profile of fuel cell technologies on Capitol Hill.

Before FCHEA, Justin served as the Legislative Representative at Alliance Management Group, a boutique trade association management firm. In this position, he advocated on behalf of the National Retail Federation's supply chain policy agenda, among other clients' priorities. Working with a coalition of retail industry representatives, Justin helped to secure several important provisions for multimodal transportation in the 2015 *Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act*.
